<p>What is the organization's primary exempt purpose? <b>▶</b> The Prem Rawat Foundation is dedicated to promoting and disseminating the lectures, speeches, art, music, humanitarian efforts, and public forums of Prem Rawat, also known as Maharaji. The Foundation creates and publishes print, audio, video, and internet-based communications to present his message to a broad spectrum of audiences across cultures. An important part of the Foundation's mission is to help improve the quality of life for people most in need. The Foundation sponsors food support programs in India, provides relief to victims of disasters around the world, and assists other organizations that support charitable, social, or philanthropic programs and services consistent with Prem Rawat's message of peace.</p> <p>All organizations must describe their exempt purpose achievements in a clear and concise manner. <p><b>a</b> THREE DISTINCT AREAS OF PROGRAM SUPPORT AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS</p> <p><b>1</b> Disaster Relief and Support Grants. TPRF is often one of the first to respond to the immediate needs of people affected by disasters, thanks to its partnerships with some of the world's most trusted and effective nonprofit organizations. TPRF also partners with nonprofit organizations to help people shift out of cycles of poverty and become more self-reliant. Initiatives funded by TPRF in 2007 provided 80,000 meals to at-risk children through the Houston Food Bank's Kids Caf project, nutrition allowances for visually impaired, deaf, and intellectually disabled students at special schools in China, support to the UN World Food Programme to help provide food and other necessities to 80,000 people in Peru in the wake of a devastating earthquake, nutritious meals, snacks, and safe water to 300 children in Cambodia, food to 600 children in Argentina who require "medical feeding" due to severe malnutrition, food, milk, safe water, and restored water systems in Indonesia after floods, an earthquake, and a volcano, fertilizer for farmers and clothing for children in Mexico, aiding 1,000 people after a flood, food to women and children in Mozambique after a cyclone and flood, and an ongoing breakfast program for malnourished children in Australia. In its humanitarian initiatives, TPRF partners with some of the best-known volunteer and humanitarian organizations in the world, including -Feeding America (formerly America's Second Harvest)-Oxfam-Friends of the World Food Program, a support organization for The United Nations World Food Programme -Rotary -The Houston Food Bank-National Council of Women in the United States-Voluntary Service Overseas-Foundation for Community Development.</p> <p><b>2</b> Message of Peace-TPRF helps to make Prem Rawat's message of peace available via the production and distribution of inspirational and educational materials and the coordination of personal speaking engagements. In 2007, TPRF helped people discover Prem Rawat's message of peace by producing and distributing materials like ADI magazine, the Inspire newsletter, and DVDs of Prem Rawat's presentations. TPRF also supported a number of personal appearances by Prem Rawat, including at an event celebrating the opening of the border between Italy and Slovenia, an address at the Australian Parliament Buildings on the United Nations International Day of Peace, and an event honoring Prem Rawat at London's Guildhall, among others.</p> <p><b>3</b> Ongoing Program Sponsorship Eye Clinics-In 2007, two Eye Clinics were held by TPRF in collaboration with Raj Vidya Kender and Premsagar Foundation, making a total of 10 since 2003. In 2007, nearly 3,500 people were given full eye examinations, more than 2,200 people received free eyeglasses, and the volunteer doctors and assistants administered more than 2,100 eye drops.</p> <p>Food for People (FFP)-In its third year of operation, FFP is testament to the vision of Prem Rawat and the Foundation of offering assistance in a way that respects local customs and individuals' dignity. FFP serves more than 100,000 hot, nutritious, indigenous meals each year from a 10,000 square-foot facility built and staffed by local villagers. Food is purchased from local markets as well as grown on FFP land, further supporting the local economy, and meals are planned with input from the village elders.
